

Enabling the Library Resources Link in a Canvas Course


The **Library Resources** link provides students with quick and easy access to Kares Library resources that are specific to the subject of each course in Canvas. This link may already be available in your course via the **Course Navigation** menu. If it is not, however, you can enable it for use by your students by completing the following steps:

1. Open the course in Canvas and click the **Settings** link (the last link) in the **Course Navigation** menu to the left.




The *Settings* page appears.

2. Click the **Navigation** link tab.

The screenshot shows the 'Navigation' tab in a course management system. It features two main sections for configuring course navigation links.





3. Locate the **Library Resources** tiles in the lower section of tiles.



4. Click the tile and while continuing to hold the left mouse button, drag and drop the **Library Resources** tiles into the upper section of tiles.



5. Scroll to the bottom of the screen and click the **Save** button.



The **Library Resources** link is now enabled and available to students via the **Course Navigation** menu. You may have to refresh the page to see the link.
