The Home (default) screen is displayed when the phone is in the idle state. The Home screen displays status indicators, user directory number, avatar, last dialed number, time, date and list of programmable softkeys.

Make Calls:

1. Intercom call – please note all ext's are now 4 digits. They all match the last 4 digits of the phone number assigned.

2. Outbound call – Dial 9, then the 10 digit phone number

Hold: With caller live on the phone press the hold key. To retrieve press the line key

Mute: Press to mute your voice (LED will be red when muted). Press again to disable

Call-back: If user is busy or not answering you can select call me back in the display. This will ring your phone when that user becomes available Call Me Back

Cold Transfer



With caller live on the phone, press Transfer soft key in display

Enter in Extension or Outside number (using 9 for outbound)

Press the soft transfer key in display to complete

Warm Transfer



With caller live on the phone, press Transfer soft key in display

Enter in Extension or Outside number (using 9 for outbound)

> Wait for the user to answer, then press the soft transfer key in display to complete

Transfer to Voicemail



With caller live on the phone, press Transfer soft key in display and enter in the extension

Quickly press the more key in the display

Press to voicemail in the display to complete

Conference Calls



With caller live on the phone, press Add User soft key in display

> Dial 2nd party extension or phone number (remember to use 9 for outside)

> > With 2nd caller live on the phone, press Join Calls softkey in display to Join all parties
